John 20:26-29*

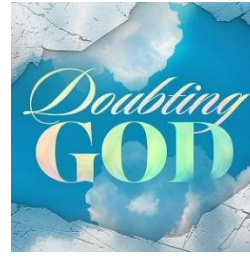
