At The Quest, service makes the difference!

Our amazing team of partners and regular attenders give generous gifts of their time and talents to God and others. That makes our church great. You would be surprised at what volunteers do around the church each week – from singing to cleaning, teaching to pulling weeds, and just about everything in between. Each worship gathering we hold requires a team of at least 75 volunteers and we currently hold 3 worship gatherings each Sunday morning. No matter what your interests or gifts, there is a place where you can make a real difference by sharing your life and love with others at The Quest.

Serving on a Quest team honors God and builds a healthy church as well as being a great way to meet people, build friendships and have a blast!

There are many different opportunities to serve at The Quest. Some positions require as little as 30 minutes per week. Our schedule of 2 worship gatherings each Sunday morning not only helps us reach our community by offering multiple worship times, but it also makes it easier to... **WORK ONE, WORSHIP ONE**.


Almost all of our teams offer a schedule that allows you to serve others during one worship gathering and then worship with others in the next gathering or vice-versa (worship then serve). You can experience the joy and fulfillment of making a difference by serving others and also have your spiritual tank filled in a worship gathering each week.

The following pages provide a brief description of our primary volunteer positions. Each of these roles plays a critical function in helping us fulfill our mission of "proclaiming the Good News and offering healing for life's hurts."

Take some time to look over all the opportunities and see which one(s) interest you the most. You are welcome to try as many as you like as you seek the one that best fits your available time, gifts, abilities and heart. Many people choose to serve in multiple areas and that's just fine. We have several positions that allow you to serve and worship in the same gathering.

GET CONNECTED

It's easy to get plugged in at The Quest. We have an Equipping Pastor, Connections Pastors and Team Leaders who will help you get started and equip you as you serve. Don't worry we'll never lock you in a room full of toddlers and expect you to fight your way to freedom! Primary Volunteer Positions

Parking Team

Welcome people to The Quest by directing them to parking spaces and entry doors – time commitment 30 minutes prior to worship gathering. Operates a golf-cart to shuttle people to and from the remote parking areas. Team members may leave the parking lot 10 minutes after the gathering starts. 1 team member stays in the parking lot and provides security during the entire gathering. *Qualifications* – *outgoing*, *friendly*, *undeterred* by *climate*.

Greeting Team

Welcome people to The Quest by directing them upon entering the building and providing the weekly worship guide — time commitment 30 minutes prior to worship gathering. Qualifications — friendly, hospitable, good with names, desire to help others feel comfortable at The Quest.

Hosting Team

The general purpose of a host is to welcome, inform and facilitate guest introduction to The Quest by engaging the guest and guiding them to the appropriate ministry for babies, children, cafe, etc. – time commitment 30 minutes prior to worship gathering. Qualifications – friendly, hospitable, good with names, knowledge of The Quest facilities, teams and events, desire to help others feel comfortable at The Quest.

Café Team

Provide friendly, courteous sales of café items – time commitment 45 minutes prior to worship gathering. Cafe personnel close the cafe and enter the worship gathering at 15 minutes after the gathering starts. *Qualifications – customer service skills, ability to make proper change, good hygiene.*

BabyQuest Team (Background Check Required)

Provide diligent and loving care for children ages birth – 18 months during worship gatherings – time commitment 30 minutes prior to worship gathering and during one gathering. Qualifications – love for babies, tender and nurturing heart, background check.

ToddlerQuest Team (Background Check Required)

Provide diligent and loving care for children ages 18 months - 3 years during worship gatherings – time commitment 30 minutes prior to worship gathering and during one gathering. *Qualifications – love for babies, tender and nurturing heart, background check.*

KinderQuest Team (Background Check Required)

Take an active role in the worship experience for children ages 3 - Kindergarten, opportunities range from teaching to assisting with crafts and games — time commitment 30 minutes prior to worship gathering and during one gathering.

Qualifications — love for children, high energy, desire to help children grow in their faith, background check.

KidsQuest Team (Background Check Required)

Take an active role in the worship experience for children in 1-6th grade, opportunities range from teaching to assisting in games and activities — time commitment varies by position. The KidsQuest ministry currently operates with multiple teams. *Qualifications* — *love for children, high energy, desire to help children grow in their faith, background check.*

Media Technician

Operate graphics computer for presentation of images, text and video on screen . Operate video computer for live streaming to the web – time commitment – 120 minutes prior to and during worship gathering. *Qualifications – high attention to detail, basic computer skills, and ability to remain focused on speaker's physical and verbal cues for prompt transitions. Willingness to follow instruction from media team leader.*

Sound Technician

Operate sound equipment to produce quality sound during the worship experience – time commitment – 2 hour mid-week rehearsal and 90 minutes prior to and during worship gathering. Qualifications – good ear for sound, willingness to follow instructions, high attention to detail, and commitment to learning sound operation skills.

Camera Operator

Operate video camera(s) to capture quality video of the main speaker and specified elements during the worship gathering—time commitment 30 minutes prior to and during worship gathering. Qualifications—high attention to detail, willingness to follow instruction from media team leader, commitment to learning skills in video camera operations.

Lighting Technician

Operate lighting controls to produce quality visual enhancement during the worship experience – time commitment 30 minutes prior to and during worship gathering. Qualifications – high attention to detail, willingness to follow instruction from media team leader, commitment to learning lighting skills.

Worship Team / Band

Use your musical ability to enhance the worship experience at The Quest by singing or playing an instrument – time commitment –2 hour mid-week rehearsal, 90 minutes prior to and during worship gathering. Plus practice time on your own. Qualifications – ability to sing on key with a live band or ability to play a musical instrument with basic proficiency. High level of commitment to excellence. Value of worship over performance. Willingness to receive and follow instruction from the worship minister.

TeenQuest Team (Background Check Required)

Help middle school or high school students connect with The Quest and grow in their faith, opportunities range from teaching to providing transportation for events – time commitment –Sunday nights 5:30-8:15pm and monthly events. *Qualifications – love for teenagers, highly relational, available to attend weekly meetings and monthly events.*

Special Events Team (SET)

Plan, prepare and serve large meals at special events as well as help with set up and tear down when needed – time commitment based on the event (events occur about every other month). Qualifications – ability to work with others to prepare and serve delicious meals as well as move tables, chairs, etc.

Fusion Team

This team assists with guest follow-up and other forms of essential office and communication related tasks as needed – time commitment –1-3 hours on an as needed basis. Qualifications – good organizational skills and attention to detail, ability to work well on a team.

Grounds Keeper

Keep The Quest beautiful by maintaining the exterior of the building. Pull weeds, plant flowers, pick up trash, mow grass, etc. – time commitment – weekly, adjustable to your schedule. Qualifications – green thumb, attention to detail, desire to serve by enhancing the exterior appearance of The Quest.

Pre-Gathering Team

This team assists in preparing the worship center prior to the 1st gathering; placing table cloths, preparing worship guides, final preparations prior the 1st gathering of the day – time commitment – 1.5 hours prior to the 1st worship gathering. *Qualifications – ability to work with others, attention to detail, and willing to prepare the facilities for scheduled church gatherings, etc.*

Mid-Gathering Team

This team assists with resetting the worship center and lobby between scheduled gatherings.; empty trash receptacles, clear tables, straighten and re-organize tables and chairs – time commitment – 30 minutes between each gathering. *Qualifications* – ability to work with others, attention to detail, and willing to prepare the facilities for scheduled church gatherings, etc.

YOUR TEAM

As the church grows additional opportunities to serve become available. Opportunities to serve may not be listed in this document, however that doesn't mean an area that meets your gifting isn't available.
